GETTING STARTED WITH.....3D PRINTING!

A Washington Public Library card in good standing is required, as well as a signed MakelT Place User Agreement.

Patrons are not allowed to operate the 3D printers.

Patrons may submit a file using the 3D Print request form on the WPL website 3D Print Request.

Library Staff will contact the Patron submitting the print to verify specifics and give estimates on price and when the item will be ready for pick up.

Patrons are responsible for paying for their files that are sent to the WPL.

Patrons are responsible for finding their own files for their desired print.
