



Washington Public Library Construction Update

In April the library sustained extreme damage from a 1,000 pound piece of glass that fell from our 3rd floor to our main floor shattering glass throughout both floors and damaging the atrium area upstairs. Over the months of July and August the library will be undergoing internal construction as a result of this. We will be re-carpeting the whole library, securing all of the internal windows with frames, and re-build the atrium area securely.

We will be updating the community weekly on what areas of the library are closed or if the library will be closed on a certain day. We will notify patrons by posting the weekly updates on the door of the library, WPL Facebook Page, and our webpage. There is a chance we may have to close the library for a couple days when we have bigger machines moving shelves.

Conference rooms will be closed through both June and July as they will be full of furniture and will also be re-carpeted.

Please remember, we still do offer curbside service and we'd be happy to provide books to you in this way if you choose not to enter the library while this construction is taking place.
