

## GETTING STARTED WITH.....THE CRICUT!

A Washington Public Library card in good standing is required, as well as a signed MakeIT Place User Agreement.

Patrons must go through the certification process to use the Cricut or demonstrate prior Cricut experience.

Check the MakeIT Place calendar for available times and use the [Library's Event Calendar](#) to sign up for the Learn Design Space Class Part 1 and Part 2. Each class will usually take between 60-90 minutes to complete. Patrons may take the classes more than once to feel comfortable.

Reserve a time slot on WPL website [Cricut :: Washington Free Public Library](http://www.washington.lib.ia.us)

Reserve a computer on the WPL website [MakelT Place Graphic Design page](#)

The Cricut and computer can be reserved in 2 hour blocks with a maximum of 6 hours of usage per week.

Come to WPL at your reserved time.

Sign in at the circulation desk to access the MakeIT Place.

Purchase/approve materials at the circulation desk.

Follow the posted process in the machine area.

Sign out at the circulation desk when leaving the MakeIT Place.
