A Washington Public Library card in good standing is required, as well as a signed MakeIT Place User Agreement.

Patrons must go through the certification process to use the Recording Studio.

- Patrons must take one free Audio 101 class  
(or more if you want to feel more comfortable)

A class will usually take 2 hours.

## I'm certified for the RECORDING STUDIO...now what?

Reserve a time slot on WPL website [MakeIT Place Recording Studio page](#)

Come to WPL at your reserved time.

Sign in at the circulation desk to access the MakeIT Place.

Follow procedures to use the Recording Studio.

No recordings are saved on the Mac Studio System.

Save your recordings on a Flash Drive or SD card. These can be purchased at the circulation desk by filling out a material request form.

Clean up the Recording Studio prior to leaving.

Sign out at the circulation desk upon leaving the MakeIT Place.

The Recording Studio is available in 2 hour time blocks up to 6 hours weekly.
